## ERIN CARROLL WINS STELLA ARTOIS WORLD DRAUGHT MASTER COMPETITION

De Post bartender extraordinaire Erin Carroll took out the World Draught Master Competition in Leuven, Belgium today, the second time in the competition's eleven year history that a team member from De Post has won this competition.

The competition rewards the world's best pourer of Belgian beers, a unique art form in which the pourer must demonstrate a full knowledge of the brewing process and style of each beer, as well as being able to pour and present a perfect glass every time.

The pouring ritual around which the competitors are judged by a panel of experts includes their cleaning process, the position of the tap (not touching the beer, head or glass), the size of the head (no higher than two fingers), and a careful re-dipping of the glass in cool water to restore its proper drinking temperature.



Erin beat bar tenders from 23 other countries to take out this competition, following months of training and mentoring by her De Post colleague, Meghan Wales, who was so committed to helping Erin win that she accompanied Erin to Belgium for the event.
